Authorised vaccinator/registered pharmacist vaccinator pathway

- Complete the pre-reading – see next section
- Undertake 18 hours theory
- Complete an open book assessment
- Complete a clinical assessment on a minimum of two vaccinations appropriate to the clinical area

Required pre-reading

Complete pre-reading of the current *Immunisation Handbook*:

- Introduction
- General immunisation principles
- Appendices 3 & 4

Course priority

Those delivering childhood schedule vaccines will get priority on two day vaccinator training courses.

Can enrolled nurses undertake a vaccinator training course?

Yes, but they are generally not awarded authorised vaccinator status – contact the local Medical Officer of Health for confirmation.

To avoid disappointment

- Registration with payment required at least 6 weeks prior to course date
- Courses will only be held if minimum numbers are met 3 weeks before the course

No refunds – please choose carefully

- Three weeks written notice required to education office if withdrawing from course – one transfer permitted in same calendar year
- No late cancellations – fee is forfeited

Online Immunisation Updates

Four hour updates for vaccinators, GPs and midwives are available online \$90:

- Vaccinator update: infants to adults
- Vaccinator update: adolescents to adults
- Vaccinator update: public health nurses (includes HPV module)
- Vaccinator update: pharmacists
- Midwives immunisation update (accredited for education hours by the Midwifery Council of New Zealand)

We also offer the following online courses:

- Tuberculosis, skin testing and BCG vaccination – approximately eight hours (for those authorised vaccinators in public health who require endorsement) \$110
- HPV Vaccination – approximately one hour and FREE
- Introduction to immunisation – approximately four hours and FREE
- Storage and handling of vaccines – approximately one hour and FREE
